## **HEALTH NOTICE: MUMPS IN THE COMMUNITY**

We've been informed of a recent case of mumps in the local community. Mumps is a contagious viral illness that can spread quickly, particularly in school settings.

While most people recover fully, the infection can be more serious for teenagers and young adults.

If your child or their siblings attend different schools, please follow these important steps to help keep everyone safe:

### **1. Practice Good Hygiene**

- Wash hands regularly with soap and water.
- Don't share drinks, food, or cutlery.
- Cover mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing.

### **2. Watch for Symptoms**

Be alert for:

- Swollen cheeks or jaw
- Fever
- Headache or muscle aches
- Tiredness and loss of appetite

If your child or a sibling has any of these symptoms, please keep them home and contact your GP.

### **3. Check Vaccination Status**

Make sure your children are up to date with the MMR vaccine (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), which protects against mumps.

### **4. Inform All Schools**

If a case is confirmed in your family, please notify every school your children attend. This helps protect other students and staff.

If you have any concerns or need further advice, please contact your GP or local health services.
