HAVE YOU PAID YOUR FEES FOR 2016?

Zayed College for Girls is a state integrated school. We are government funded to teach the national curriculum. However, the land and buildings are not owned by the government. Because of this we DO NOT get funding from the government for capital works on the land and buildings. This funding comes from the Proprietors, Al Nahyan Trust.

Section 36 of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 enables Proprietors to collect attendance dues. This money is then used to pay for improvements to the land and buildings.

This is a legal and compulsory payment by parents each year your daughter attends Zayed College for Girls.
